1. Inspect closely the tires, decking, lights, couple and safety chains before leaving the business premises. Any problems that occur after the customer leaves are assumed by the customer (Flat tires, ETC.)
2. Periodically double check lights, chains, load binders, ball and decking to insure your continued safety down the road.
3. Drive safely for any weather and terrain conditions
4. Obey all traffic laws, especially the speed limit
5. When distributing load weight, remember that 60% of it should be in front of the trailer center line. Tongue Weight should never be less than 10% of the load. If you feel that the load is insecure or fishtailing, slow down gradually and stop. Fishtailing is an indication of improper load distribution. Reposition and secure the load properly.
6. Secure tractors and automobiles with at least four transport chains and load binders.
7. Loading ramps must always be in predetermined positions. Do not transport equipment without ramps being locked in the proper position. Under no circumstances should the ramps be removed from the trailer.
8. Do not exceed load capacity of the trailer.
9. Do not disconnect the trailer from the towing vehicle.
10. Anticipate stops. Allow a more than sufficient gap between you and the vehicle in front of you.
11. Have a safe trip!

Trailer Rental Policies:

Crown Rental is a locally owned and operated rental company serving the south metro area. Crown Rental will respond to any service needs within a 50 mile radius of the rental store. If you the customer travels outside of the 50 mile radius any repairs needed become your sole responsibility.

Crown rental has a strict maintenance program to prevent any unforeseen problems, but due to the many outside factors like road hazards, overloading, hitting of curbs, ETC., we cannot prevent them all. It is the customer's responsibility to drive in a safe manner at all times and to avoid any hazards that may cause damage to the trailer. Excessive tire damage caused by pulling the trailer on a flat tire or hitting solid objects will be considered abuse/neglect and will result in replacement charges applied to the final invoice. We will attach the trailer to your vehicle and inspect your hitch for proper rating for the trailer and we will check to make sure the lights are operating properly before you leave. Please do not disconnect the trailer while it is in your possession. Please feel free to inspect the trailer before leaving the lot and discuss any questions with our employees.
